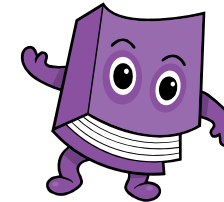

ONE. Count the pages of your book

TWO. Use a calendar to count the days and weeks that you have between today and the day of delivery of your book report.

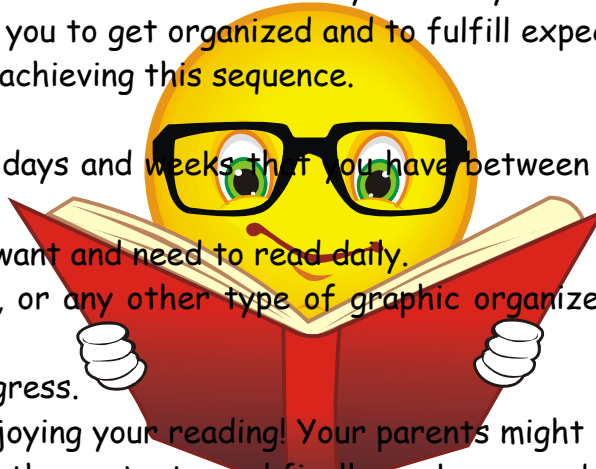
THREE. Decide how many pages you want and need to read daily.

FOUR. Make a calendar, a time line, or any other type of graphic organizer to help you keep a nice and smooth rhythm when reading.

FIVE. Make sure you check your progress.

SIX. The rule you must follow is enjoying your reading! Your parents might help you read, and then you can repeat the sentences, make comments about the contents, and finally work on your book report.

SEVEN. If for any reason you find the book the student chose is not attractive, please feel free to report this to the teacher so a different alternative can be sent home. Or, if there is a book you own that your child and you believe could be a good option to be read and reported, please send it for the teacher to approve its reading.
